



RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT- FLOATING LOCAL OPTAINS SALES TAX (FLOST)

WHEREAS, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp signed House Bill 581 on April 18, 2024, a measure focused on property tax relief. The law went into effect on January 1, 2025, after a related constitutional amendment (HR 1022) was approved by Georgia voters in November 2024; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 581 also created an optional sales tax for local governments, known as the Floating Local Option Sales Tax (FLOST), for the sole purpose of reducing property taxes. The implementation of FLOST requires voter approval in a local referendum; and

WHEREAS, the City of Newnan and Coweta County entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement calling for a county-wide referendum on November 4, 2025, asking voters if FLOST will be imposed; and

WHEREAS, if passed by voters, revenue collections from FLOST will begin January 1, 2026. It is estimated that FLOST proceeds collected by the City of Newnan will exceed property tax collections.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Newnan will be required to set a millage in August of 2026 for the 2026 Budget Year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Newnan, Georgia, hereby acknowledge and support the following:

1. Provided the FLOST referendum is successful on November 4, 2025, the City Council supports reducing the Millage Rate of the City of Newnan to "0.00" in August of 2026.

Council Approves Resolution to Reduce Millage Rate

On Tuesday, during the City Council meeting, Council approved a resolution to support the reduction of the millage rate to 0.00, eliminating property taxes collected by the City of Newnan by August 2026. For more information, visit the City of Newnan website.
