

If you have a lot of paint that needs to get recycled, stop by the Newnan City Hall parking lot from 8:00am-12:00pm.

\$4 a gallon for latex paint; \$5 a gallon for oil paint – City of Newnan residents get a discount of a \$1 off.

We only accept wet paint that is free from additives (i.e. No kitty litter, sand, etc.)

Current license required for address verification.


